Program Notes

Music holds a strange power. It speaks to the extreme conditions of life - to joy and gladness, grief and sorrow. In that strange, unknowable way, music is our companion, and a gift we can freely give to others. So go and make music!

Performance Notes

- * Measures 1-16, and similar passages: Flow smoothly between each "Orpheus", lifting only where rests are indicated.
- * Ensure that the long "Or" syllable in "Orpheus" doesn't close to the "r" until the last possible moment. It should sound like "Oh".
- * Exaggerate the hairpins. Shape the phrases like waves on the sea. Bring them to life!
